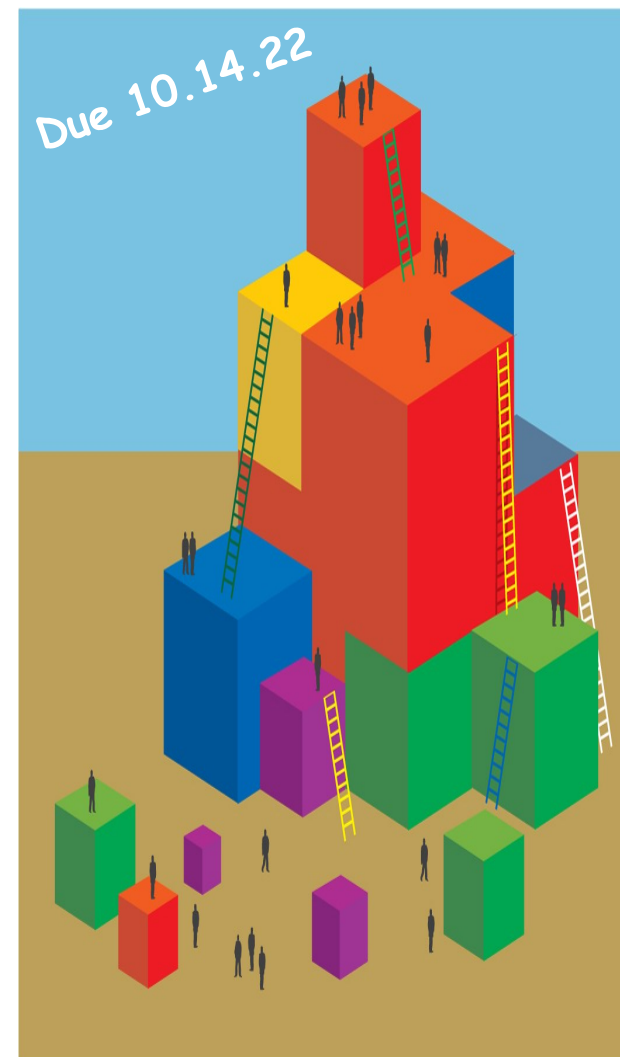

GUIDELINES

- A. Grant proposals may be written for any amount up to \$1,000. and can be submitted by K-12 grade educator(s).
- B. Applicants may submit only one proposal.
- C. The deadline for submission of proposals is October 14, 2022.
- D. Grants will be awarded by December 1, 2022
- E. Grantees are required to: electronically send a one-page summary report of their funded grant by May 1, 2023, including district match, and
 - provide 4-5 digital photos.
 - Submit a summary report (provided by SPIE) of their funded grant by May 1, 2023.

Please submit your grant proposal electronically, providing the following information:

- A. Name(s) & title(s)
- B. School
- C. School District
- D. Grade level(s)
- E. Number of students served
- F. Principal
- G. School telephone number
- H. Proposal title
- I. Write a description of the proposal that includes measurable objectives.
- J. An explanation of how grant funding will be used to meet proposal objectives.
 - 1. Specify how \$1,000 will be budgeted (*i.e.*, supplies, software).
 - 2. Indicate the cash or in-kind contributions that will be provided by the school, PTA, school clubs, businesses, other. If any.
- K. Provide the following:
 - 1. Start date of program and/or activities.
 - 2. Timeline of program/activities.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Each proposal will be scored on the following criteria:

- 1. Evidence of a detailed budget and mandatory financial or in-kind match.... 15 pts
- 1. Evidence of business linkages.....15 pts (*partnerships, advisory, contributions, etc.*)
- 3. Scope of student participation..... 15 pts (*school wide, classroom, grade specific, other*)
- 4. Measurable objectives & timeline.....15 pts
- 5. Proposal effectiveness meeting the concepts defined in "Grant Focus" 20 pts
- 6. Evidence of curriculum integration.....15 pts (*correlation between school and work*)
- 7. Approximate date(s) proposal will be implemented..... 5 pts
